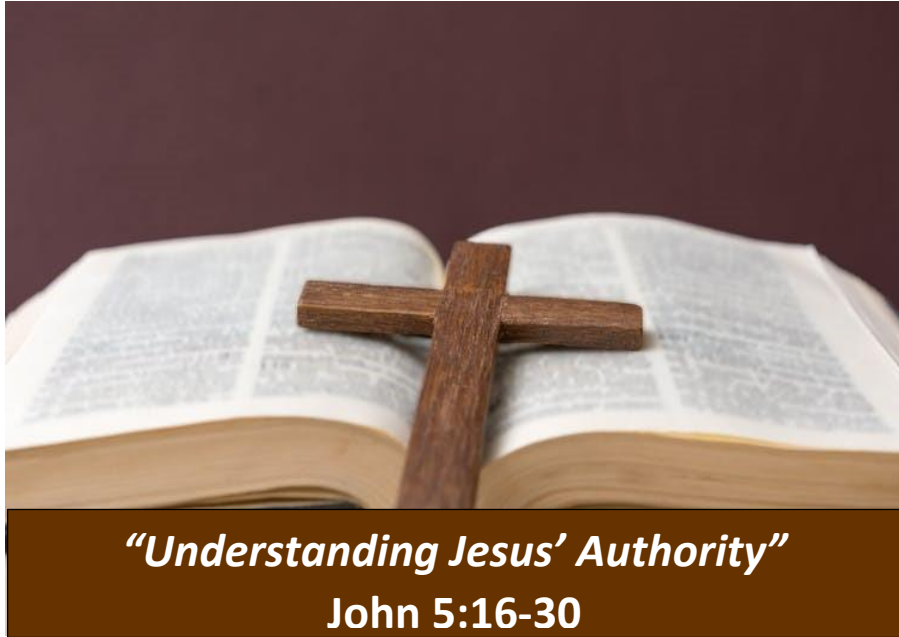


**Sunday, October 11, 2020**

Fall Series: "Nobody but Jesus"- Studies in John's Good News about Jesus



“Was there ever a time in your life when you were left behind? How did you feel? What did you do?”

Read John 5:1-6. Jesus meets a man who has been ill for 38 years and asks him the question, “Do you want to get well?” Are there areas in my life where I really don’t want Jesus to heal me?

In John 5:16 the Jewish leaders again were angry with Jesus. Not just for the miracles, but because he told the man to break the law by carrying his mat on the Sabbath. Are there times we hold to “the letter of the law” and miss what God is doing?

John 5:19 Jesus says he can only do what He sees the Father doing. Based upon what Jesus does, what can you say God is doing? Is that a different picture of God than you imagine?

Read John 5:23 again. Based upon my relationship with Jesus, can I say I am honoring God? What needs to change?

John 5:24-27 Jesus has authority to judge death and life. What verdict would he pronounce on me? Read Matthew 24:36-51. Am I afraid of being “left behind.” Who do I fear may be? What am I doing about it?

Read John 5:25-27. Jesus as the “Son of Man” has the right to judge, because sharing human form he understands the temptations we face, and could overcome with God’s help. What am I facing now that I need God’s help in overcoming?

“PRAY FOR ONE”- For whom does God place on my heart to pray for an intentional opportunity to intentionally share the good news of Jesus? Will I commit to pray along those lines between now and the end of the year? Who will pray with me?
