"Understanding Jesus' Provision"

John 6:25-59

"Do I view Jesus as my provider, or my provision? Is there a difference for me?"

Read John 6:35. How would you summarize this in your own words?

Read John 6:26,27. In what ways do I "work for food that spoils?" Do I know what that looks like?

Read Exodus 16:1-4. God has rescued Israel with great displays, signs of His power. When can you point to a time that God's power was obvious and evident in your own life?

Exodus 16:2 highlights that two months after their deliverance, Israel is grumbling again against God. How and when do I see myself doing the same?

Read John 6:39,40. Jesus reveals his mission and commitment to us. Complete the following sentence, "In light of Jesus' commitment to me, I am willing to..."

John 6:53 speaks to a level of intimacy and sacrifice Jesus calls me to. How would I rate my level of intimacy and sacrifice with Jesus today? What will I do to change both?

Is Jesus the only, "bread of my life?" Explain.

"PRAY FOR ONE"- For whom does God place on my heart to pray for an intentional opportunity to intentionally share the good news of Jesus? Will I commit to pray along those lines between now and the end of the year? Who will pray with me?
