“Built to Last”



“Earthquakes, Fire, Flood”
1 Peter 4:12-19

Is there a time/event in your life where you have said, “I didn’t sign up for this?” How did you respond?

In 1 Peter 4:12 Peter instructs the church how to respond when trials, persecutions occur- and they were. How well am I prepared now for being challenged in my faith? What tools I need?

Peter tells the church that they are prepared because the “Spirit of glory and God rests on them.” Read 1 Corinthians 3:16. Do I live as if God’s Spirit is living in me?

Read 1 John 4:4. What power has greater control over my life? How can I change my perspective?

Read Exodus 24:16-18. God’s glory shown through Moses when Moses spent time with God. How does God’s glory shine in and through me? Who can testify to that truth?

Read Acts 7:55. Amid Stephen’s stoning he sees Jesus. Can you think of a time when Jesus has been overwhelming real to you in a hard time? How much has that time changed you?

Read 2 Corinthians 12:9,10. How has God’s Spirit of glory empowered you to get through a trial?

Read Matthew 11:28,29. Jesus promises rest, renewal and comfort in his presence and with his spirit. How do you need find that renewal and rest and renewal in your soul today? To whom can you bring that same rest? Will you pray with someone for both of those needs?
