Summer Sermon Series 2021: "I Have a Question"



"Where is My Share?"

Habakkuk 3:16-19

On a scale of 1-10, with 10 as "high," how good are you at waiting? What is the hardest thing for you in which to wait?

Habakkuk ends with tremendous shout of confidence, "The Sovereign Lord is my strength!" To get here he had to work through tough questions and wait for God's answers. Of Habakkuk's questions, which one is hardest for you? With which one are you currently struggling?

Read 3:17,18 again slowly. What one truth about God do you see in this passage? What one obstacle in your life is keeping you from living in that truth?

Read 3:16. What is one way you can better wait patiently for God? What tangible thing can you do? What one thing with which you could use help?

Read Isaiah 41:9,10. How does hearing the truth of God's presence help you through the chapter of life you are in?

Verse 18 starts with, "yet I will rejoice." Habakkuk chooses to rejoice, even in the brokenness of life. What do you need to help you choose joy in your life? What will you do about it?

Read v 19. Two questions. Who can you help this week renew their vision of who God is in their life? What fresh commitment will you make to worship God, in community with others?
