**“Naked and Not Afraid”**  
*Genesis 3:1-21*

Have you ever been in a broken relationship? How did you feel? What was the outcome? Read Genesis 2:25. What would you give for this type of relationship?

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Genesis 1 and 2 describes the glory of God in creation. Genesis describes how it all went wrong. Read Genesis 3 slowly. What verse grabs your attention? Why?

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Genesis 3 describes the entrance of sin into creation. “Sin is the breaking and disobedience, by my words, actions, inaction or attitudes of God’s explicit or implicit commands.” How does this definition fit into your thinking?

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Read Romans 1:18-19. How often do you think of God’s wrath? Does the truth of God’s wrath affect how I live? How I think? How I interact with others?

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If I truly believed in God’s wrath, what would need to change in my life?

Meditate a moment on the idea, that even while rebellion occurred God was providing a solution. How does that change, enhance my vision of who God is?

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Have I accepted God’s solution for my sin?

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To whom can I offer God’s solution for sin this week?
